Starting from Nanny Cay, the course included Great Harbour (Peter Island), Brandywine Bay, Dead Chest, Salt Island and a circumnavigation of Cooper Island, before finishing in Road Harbour.

With such a varied course there were plenty of opportunities to fly spinnakers, as well as some tough upwind legs on the South side of Dead Chest and Salt Island.
